

GIFTED PLAN

The Wrangell Public School District will serve children between grades K-8. The elementary school (K-5) addresses individual needs within the classroom and the middle school (6-8) will have an assessment and matrix for determining a gifted student. Since the high school curriculum offers a broad spectrum of classes including college level courses, there will not be a gifted program. However, any student that is determined, as “Gifted” in the middle school will maintain that status throughout high school so that it may be included in the student’s resume and/or profile for college.
