

## GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Students shall receive diplomas of graduation from high school after meeting the district graduation requirements as listed below:

Social Studies	2 credits	3 credits
Job Skills/Career Exploration	.5 credit	.5 credit
Senior Project	.5 credit	.5 credit
Vocational	1 credit	1 credit
Fine Arts	1 credit	2 credits (must be same foreign language)
Physical Education (P.E.)	1 credit	1 credit
Health	.5 credit	.5 credit
<b>Total Specific Requirements:</b>	<b>17.5 credits</b>	<b>21.5 credits</b>
<b>Student Choice Electives:</b>	<b>6.5 credits</b>	<b>6.5 credits</b>

The School Principal at his/her discretion may reduce the number of Student Choice Electives necessary for a Standard Diploma for high school students who transfer into the district from school systems that require fewer credits to graduate. At a minimum, these students must meet all state requirements.
