

THE LEGAL ADVISORY SERVICE

The legal advisor shall be appointed, based upon the recommendation of the superintendent, for such a term and on such basis as the Board may desire and shall be compensated as the Board may determine.

The legal advisor shall advise the Superintendent of Schools, the superintendent's staff, and the Board on questions of law affecting the administration of the district. Upon request the legal advisor shall render opinions interpreting statutory law and rules and regulations of the State Department of Education and the Wrangell Public School District.

Upon request, the legal advisor shall represent the district in all litigation affecting the district.

When needed, the board may direct the legal advisor to approve forms and prepare resolutions, contracts, and other legal instruments.
