

**POLICY MANUAL**

In governing the district, the School Board has pledged to consider the will and needs of the community. The district's policy manual is developed, distributed, posted on the district website, and maintained for the purpose of communicating to interested parties, the policies, regulations, and bylaws within which our schools will operate.

The Board desires that the community and district employees have access to the policy manual. The Board welcomes suggestions from the public regarding its adopted policies and regulations. A public copy of the manual shall be maintained in the district office, so that it may be examined by students, staff, and other interested parties during normal business hours, and posted on the district website.

The Superintendent or designee shall ensure the District Policy Manual is posted on the District website for access by Board members, central office administrators, site administrators, recognized employee organizations, and other key district personnel.

As necessary, the district shall develop or revise policies and regulations to reflect new legislation and changing community views. The Superintendent or designee shall annually notify key personnel, including Board members, of additions and changes to policy.
