CHARGE FOR SCHOOL ADVISORY COMMITTEES

In an effort to include the public in the operation of the schools, the School Board will have site advisory committees who will:

- ❖ Work with the site administrator and the staff to annually review the District Mission Vision, Values and Strategic Plan Goals, recommend Annual Goals for the next fiscal year, and select and develop activities that lead toward accomplishment of Annual Goals and the strategic plan.
- ❖ Serve as the Parent Advisory Committee for various federal programs (Migrant Education, Title I, and Indian Education (IEA) etc.)
- ❖ Provide advisory input to administration concerning issues of attendance, discipline, curriculum, handbooks, asset building, extra-curricular activities, etc.
- ❖ Review and recommend revisions to the Parent Involvement Policy (*Board Policy #6020*).
- ❖ Make recommendations related to the culture and climate of the school.
- ❖ Review the Report Card to the Public.

Committees shall work under the following parameters and understandings:

1. The goals and activities should promote excellence in education.
2. They shall review Migrant Education, Title I and Indian Education (IEA) projects and give advisory input to the site administrator concerning program emphasis and directions for the coming year.
3. They shall review success of the Migrant Education, Title I and Indian Education (IEA) programs as they relate to Alaska's Quality Schools Initiative and Alaska's Performance Standards.
4. The committee should identify goals for the coming year and then provide support and rationale for the board and community.
5. The committee should assist the site administrator in evaluating the success of the programs, activities and events that were established for the current school year.

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
