

## **INTERSCHOLASTIC COMPETITION**

### **Travel for Teams**

Wrangell School District will apply the policies that are set by the Alaska School Activities Association and any other governing body that regulates state competition for a particular activity to determine the eligibility of individual students and teams to participate in state competition.

Wrangell School District may fund the transportation of its student competitors to state tournaments by providing for such funding in the approved budget.

Every effort will be made to minimize the total of number of class periods missed due to extracurricular activities.

### **Alaska School Activities Association (ASAA) Eligibility Requirements**

In order to participate in ASAA activities, a student must:

1. Be properly registered in a 9-12 high school program or any combination thereof, in the school where student will participate.
2. Be enrolled in a minimum of four classes (semester units) that lead to granting of credit for graduation.
3. Have passed, for the immediately preceding semester, at least four semester units of credit toward graduation.
4. Meet district eligibility requirements.

Semester credit rules apply to each semester, following the first semester of the ninth grade. A grade of incomplete is considered as not passing until the incomplete is changed on the official school records. With the approval of the principal, academic deficiencies may be made up through successful completion of correspondence courses or summer school. Correspondence students must meet the same time frame as regular students.

### **Eligibility Reporting**

1. The Activities Director shall submit eligibility lists for extracurricular activities five days before the first contest of each respective season on the form provided by ASAA. Any additions or deletions to the eligibility lists must be filed as an addendum to the original list before an individual is allowed to participate.
2. Activities that require eligibility lists to be filed for insurance purposes with the ASAA office are as follows:
