

USE OF SCHOOL FACILITIES

The Board believes that the schools belong to the citizens of the community and that the community use of the schools facilities fosters understanding and support for school programs. The Board shall make school facilities and grounds available to citizens and community groups for lawful gathering and assemblies to the extent that such use serves the interests of the citizens and does not conflict with school or district purposes. The Superintendent or designee shall establish administrative regulations governing the reasonable and impartial use of school facilities and grounds by community members or groups.
