

ADOPTION OF TEXTBOOKS

The Board of Education shall approve all textbooks or equivalent electronic media used in the educational program of this district. "Textbook" means the principal source of instructional material for any given course of study, in whatever form the material may be presented, that is available or distributed to every pupil enrolled in the course of study.

The Superintendent shall develop regulations for the selection of textbooks that includes effective consultation with professional staff members at all appropriate levels. The superintendent shall also establish a schedule for the review and adoption of new textbooks or equivalent electronic media.

Materials shall be free from bias and gender discrimination.
