

STUDENT LEARNING ASSESSMENT

The superintendent shall implement a program for the assessment of student achievement and instructional needs in order to determine the learning progress of students and to assist students toward attainment of the goals of the district.

The proficiencies and needs of each student will be assessed annually by faculty. Data regarding individual achievement will be entered on the student's cumulative record, where it will be subject to the policy of this Board regarding student records. The group results of each school-wide, program-wide, and district-wide test will be reported to the school board.

Parents shall be informed of the testing program of the schools and of any special tests that are to be administered to their children.

The child study team of a challenged child shall determine the extent to which a given child will participate in the district's learning assessment program.

Each year the superintendent or designee will report the latest assessment of student achievement to the public.
