

INDIAN EDUCATION PROGRAM

The Superintendent and IEA Director will collaborate to develop and implement a program to address the needs of Indian children in the District.

This program will include a means to:

1. Identify Indian students and assess their educational and related health and social needs.
2. Provide a full range of services to Indian students including applicable Title I programs, special education, vocational education and elective classes.
3. Provide Indian children with the opportunity to meet the same statewide assessment standards that all children are expected to meet.
4. Provide advocacy and outreach programs to Indian children and their families and professional development for District Indian Education Program staff.
5. Provide parents/guardians an opportunity for meaningful participation in the program.

Parent/Guardian Involvement in the Indian Education Program

Parent(s)/guardian(s) of Indian students will be involved in and regularly consulted about the development, implementation, operation and evaluation of the Indian Education program. There will be a formal meeting annually to review the program and district-related policies.

Parent(s)/guardian(s) of Indian students will receive information regarding their role in improving the academic achievement of their children.
