

HOMEBOUND INSTRUCTION

Wrangell School District shall provide homebound instruction to students whose physical, medical and/or psychological disability does not allow the child to participate in a regular school setting. One or more of the following conditions must be met for a student to participate in homebound instruction:

1. The student will have been placed in the District's special education program and homebound education will be part of the child's Individualized Education Plan as approved by the Child Study Team;
2. The nature of the disability will be for a predicted duration of fewer than forty-five calendar days.

Under condition (2) above, a physician's statement may be required before the introduction of homebound instructional services. The instructional services provided shall include weekly contact by this teacher(s) in order to facilitate the student's return to the regular classroom setting.

This policy shall not apply to students who have been suspended, expelled or otherwise excluded from school attendance.
